Dear Parents/Carer,

We have been informed of some children in the school using an app called 'TikTok.' It is an app which is a global video community where users create, share and discover 'funny and memorable moments' via short video clips. TikTok was formerly known as 'Musical.ly', before it was rebranded. In early 2019, TikTok was hit with a £4.2m fine in the US over child data privacy concerns.

Children should be over 13 to use this app and if parents allow children to use it, it is important that children's profiles are set to private. Anyone in the world can google the children's videos and anyone can comment if privacy settings have not been applied.

Please can I also remind you that the legal age limit for Instagram and WhatsApp is 13. Please be aware that if your child is using these apps with your permission, we strongly recommend that their profiles are set to private and the content posted and commented on is monitored.

DISCUSS THE PITFALLS OF OVERSHARING

Encourage your child to always think before they do, say, like or post anything antime. Explain that their 'digital footprint' shapes their online reputation and the way that other people use them. Something they may find funny and entertaining now may impact them in the future. Talk about them that with peer pressure and how doing something they think will impress others could affect them. Remind them that they do not have to de anything they are not confortable with. To ensure that there's no way of anyone tracking your child's location or identity, make it clear to them that they should never film a video in their school uniform or near a landmark that gives away where they live.

HANDLING CRITICISM

While it's fantastic to see your child being creative and expressive and bonding with people with similar interests, they need to be aware that not everyons will be supportive online. Comments can be negative or even cruel. Make sure your child knows how to comment respectfully and handle negative feedback. In the app's Privacy and Safety settings, your child can decide who can need to their videos, who can comment, and who can send them private chat messages. We suggest alhering these settings so only their friends can interact with their

REPORT INAPPROPRIATE CONTENT

If you or your crimin sees something inappropriate on TikTok, you can flag up an account, video, comment or chai by simply tapping 'Report'. In the app's 'Digital Wellbeing' feature, there's also an 'Enhanced Restricted Mode', limiting appearance of videos which may be inappropriate

USE A PRIVATE ACCOUNT

Secting up a private account means that unry people who you and your child approve of can see their creations. To make an account private, tap the three dest at the top righ of the screen to access settings. Citck Privacy and Safety. Scroll down until you find Private Account and turn this setting on.

USE THE 'DIGITAL WELLBEING' SETTING

F you're concerned about how lang your child is spending on Takfok, it has a setting called 'Digital Wellbeing' which allows you to manage the amount of screen time your child can have. We also advise that you turn off push notifications in the setting to prevent your child from receiving span-like' ostifications from TakTok that

DISCUSS IN-APP PURCHASES

To lower the risk of your child making accidental in spp porchares, teach them exactly what in spp porchares are and the risks of making them without permission. Tell hem that they are not essential to encyot the app and that if they want to make a purchase, they should always ask you beforehand, in the app's 'Digital Wellbeing' feature, there is the option to disable the function of purchasing coins and semine airts.

Users can also follow the account @tiktoktips, Tik Tok's official account fronted by established TikTok users which offers useful online safety tips for promoting safety on its platform, rather than hiding information in FAQs.
