

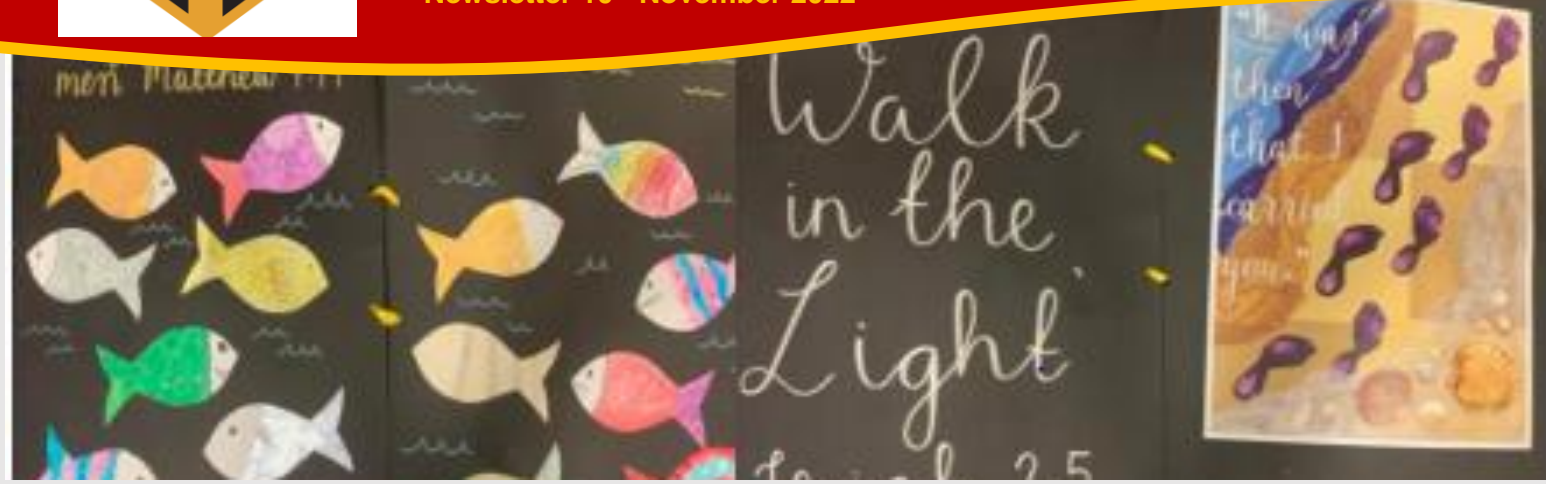

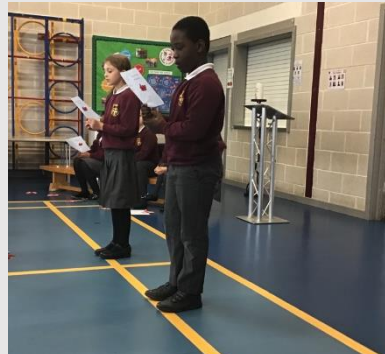
Stone Age shelters: complete!
