

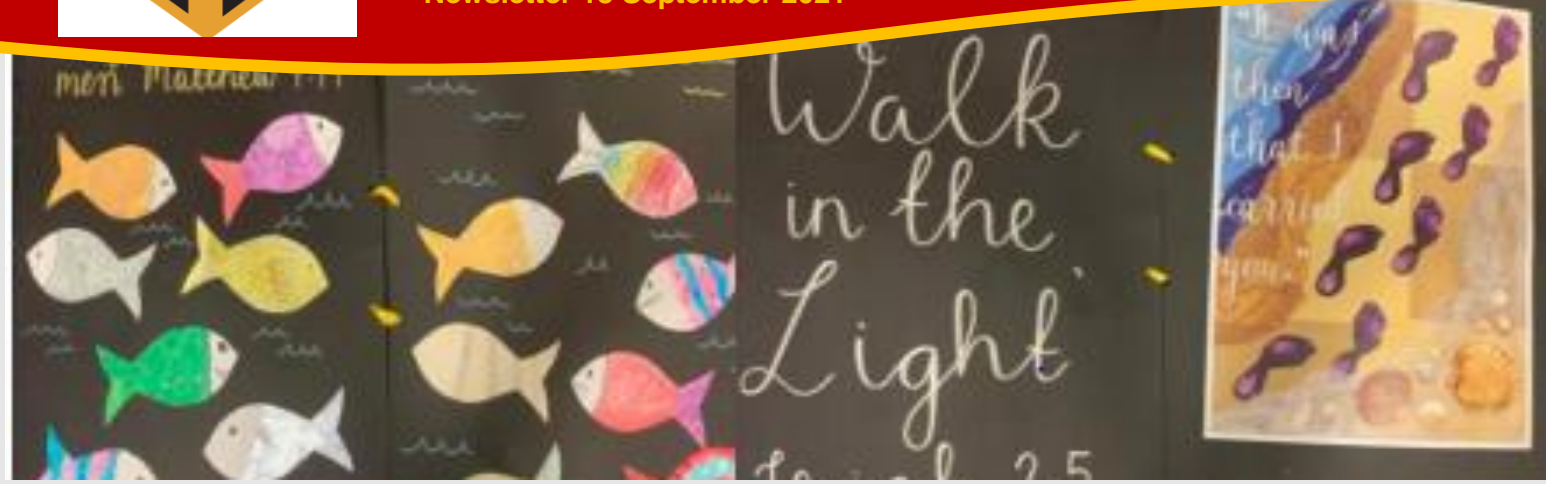

## Extra-Curricular Activities

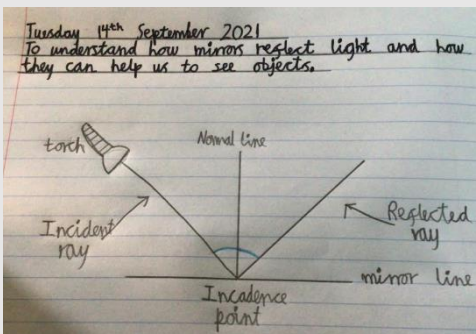

Places are still available in Pacesetter and Patrick Franks' clubs. Please contact them for more details.



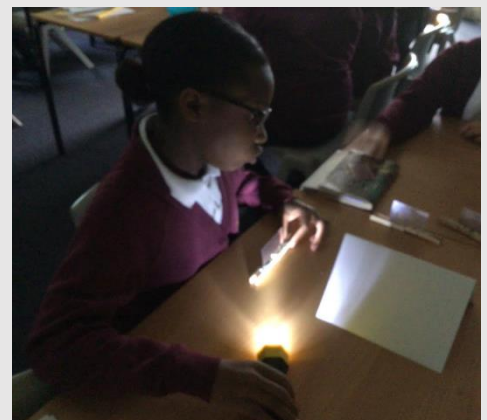
## Year 6's Light Maze Investigation
