



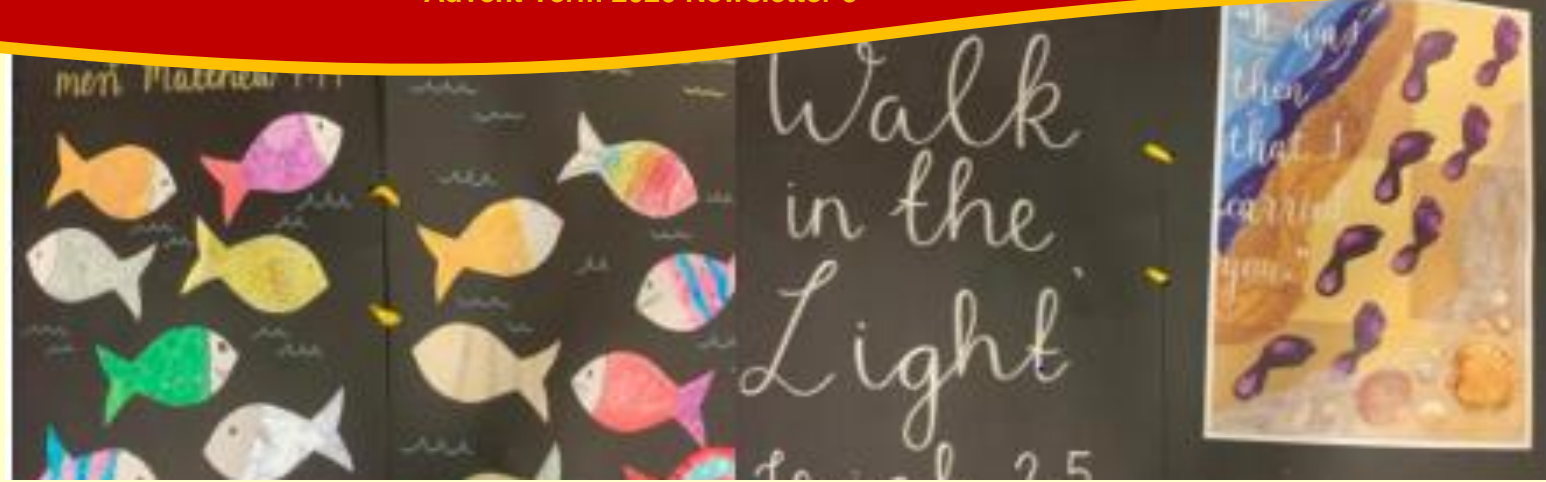

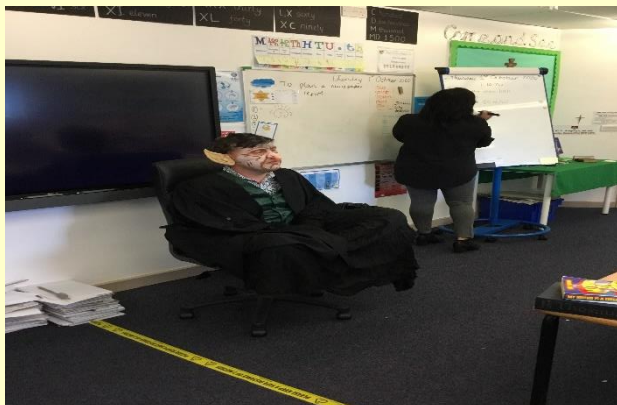

These are some of our new books bought with funds from the PTFA. They organised a Sponsored Read as part of our World Book Day celebrations.

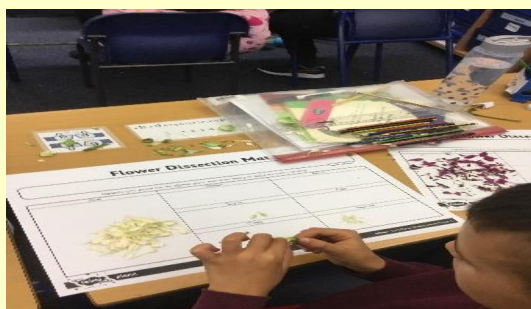
Flu Vaccination

Year 4 Ancient Egyptians WOW Day

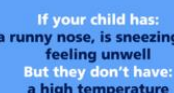


A whistlestop tour through the history of Ancient Egypt led us to a fantastic demonstration of the mummification process!
