

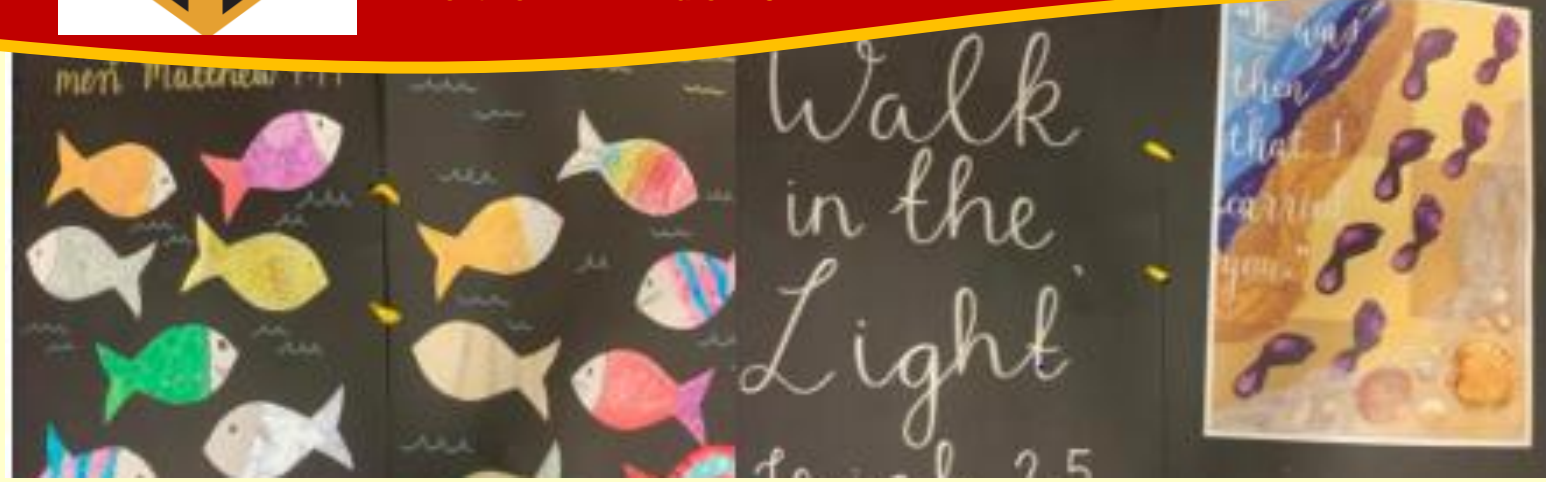

**8.45am – Nursery, Reception and Year 1+2**

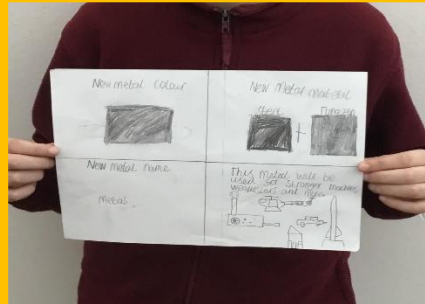
**9.00am- Years 3,4,5 and 6**

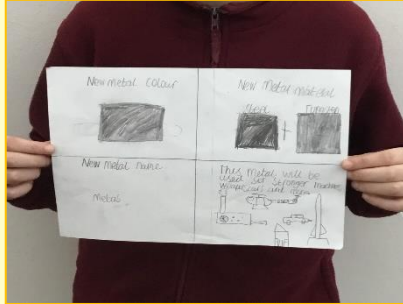
