

Working Scientifically in St Claudine Class

St Claudine Class have been exploring the process of condensation in Science this week.

'We conducted an experiment to help us investigate this important process. We poured warn water into a glass, wrapped cling film over the top and then placed an ice cube on top of the cling film. We observed how the warm water evaporated and observed the process of condensation occurring on the cooler clingfilm.
