

School Uniform and PE Kit

Thank you to all families who ensure that their child is wearing correct school uniform and PE Kit, including school shoes. Please remember that, from Reception, pupils must be wearing **grey** skirts, pinafores and tights or trousers as part of their school uniform.

From Reception and above, PE Kit must be worn, with trainers or plimsolls on PE Days:

Mondays: St David Class and St Faustina Class

Tuesdays: St Cecilia Class

Wednesdays: St Catherine of Siena Class and St Oscar Romero Class

Thursdays: St Brigid Class Fridays: St George Class

Nursery pupils should wear grey leggings and joggers along with Velcro trainer type shoes for their PE sessions which are on Tuesday mornings and Thursday afternoons.

DESIGN A SPY GADGET...



All good spies need gadgets!

Your challenge is to design a gadget for a spy.

To help create yours, you could take an everyday object and reinvent or redesign it by making it bigger, adding something and replacing or removing something.



Using the BAR method for a skateboard...

Bigger: Extend the rear of the skateboard, making it much bigger and put some shelves on it for storage.

Add: Add a small rocket motor near the back of the skateboard.

Replace/Remove: Remove the wheels and replace them with a hovercraft engine so that it floats in the air.

Pupils in Key Stage Two...

Present your gadget in a way that works for you!

You could:

- · Draw a labelled diagram of your gadget, with an explanation of how it works.
- Create a prototype, with an information card explaining how it works.
- · Design a poster to advertise your gadget so other spies will want to buy it.

Remember to:

- Make sure your name is on all parts of your entry.
- Bring your entry to school by Monday 4th March and give it to your Class Teacher.
