

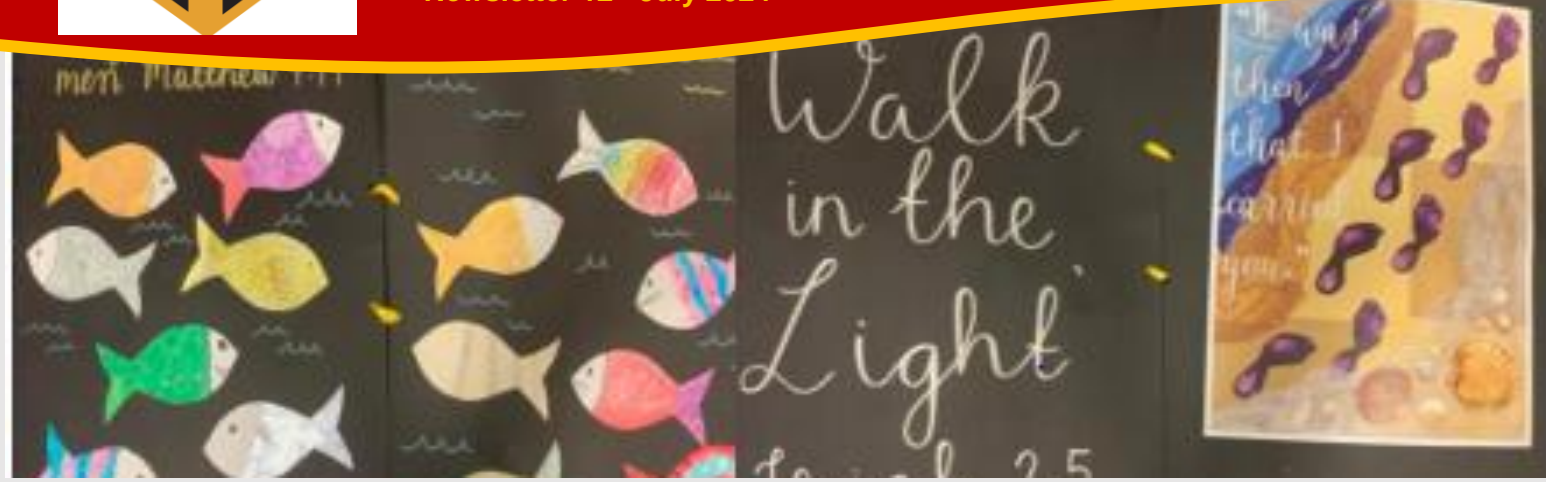

A message from Fr Stanley...

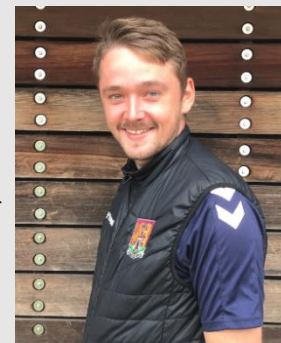
Fr Stanley, from the Cathedral Hub says the following:
