

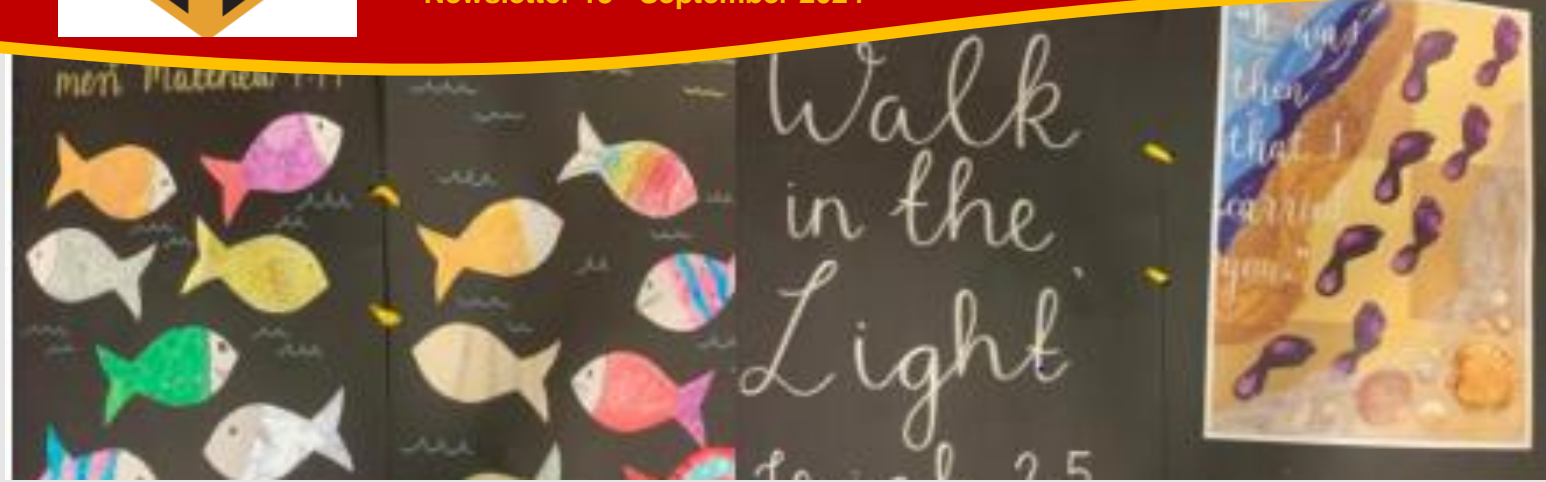

## Our School Uniform and PE Kit

For children in Reception to Year 6, pupils must wear a white polo shirt, a school sweatshirt or cardigan with school badge, grey school trousers skirt or pinafore and sensible flat black shoes. Tights must also be grey.

PE Uniform is a plain white t-shirt, plain black shorts, leggings or joggers and trainers or black plimsolls. We use our outdoor space as possible so please ensure the children are wearing joggers or leggings on cooler days. Pupils must have their school sweatshirt or cardigan in school on these days too.
