



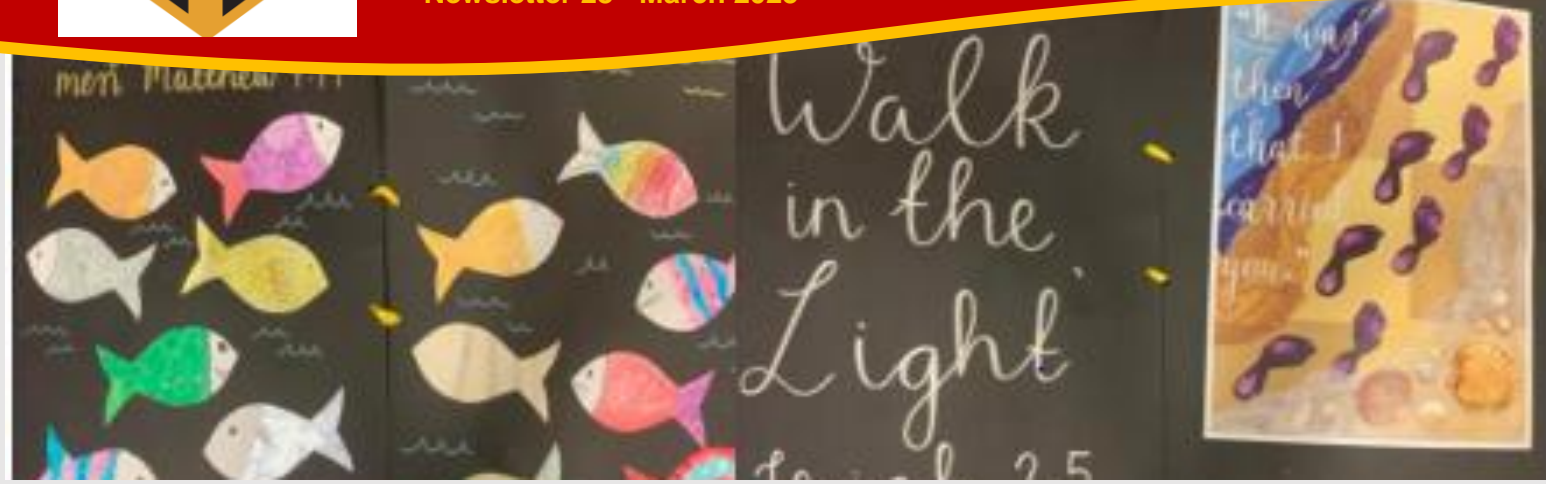

Thank you to the PTFA for running another, very successful Secret Gift Room for Mothers' Day, allowing the children to select a gift for someone special in their life. Our children in Reception have also been busy creating and writing messages in their cards to bring home this evening along with a daffodil to mark the season of Spring.



Colour theory continued...

In Art, pupils in St Bernadette class have been continuing their study of colour theory. Throughout this unit of learning, they have studied artists such as Kandinsky, Van Gogh and Monet, looking specifically at their use of colour. Their most recent piece of work shows how the mood of a piece is changed by using colour contrasts.



Doubling numbers

The children in Reception have been learning how to double numbers in their Maths lessons.

In their learning areas, they have used playdough to demonstrate their understanding and have worked to make sure the ladybirds have the same number of spots on each of their wings. They have really enjoyed challenging their friends to double their chosen number within ten.

They are now learning to record their calculations in number sentences.
