

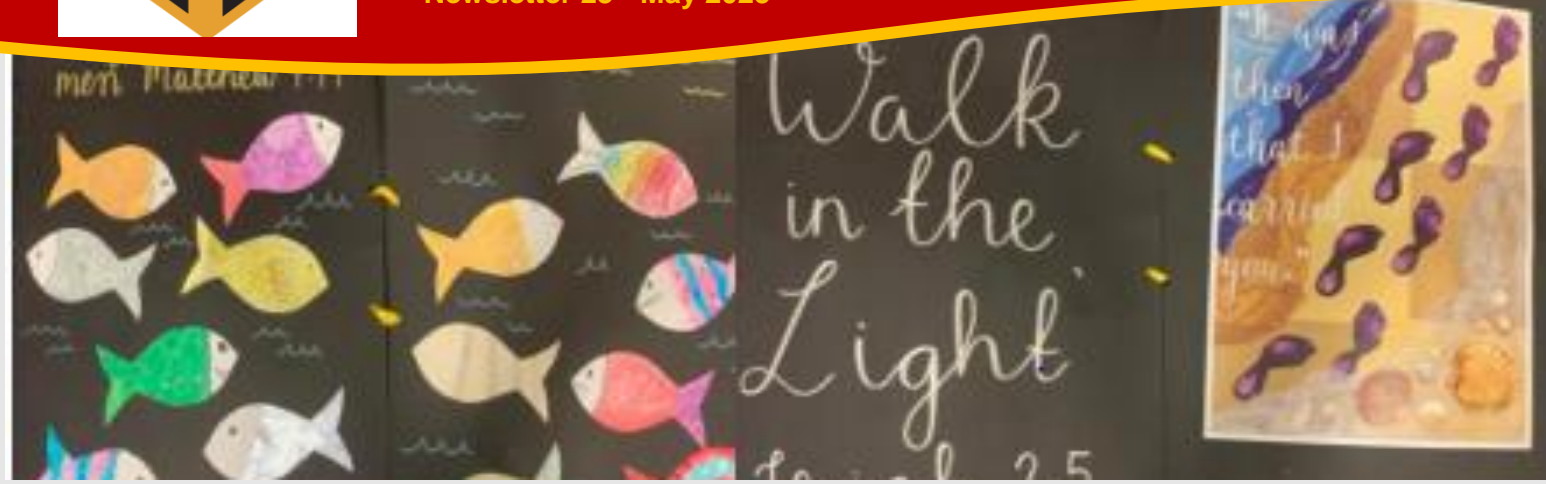

We hope you enjoy this Bank Holiday weekend and the week ahead with your children.

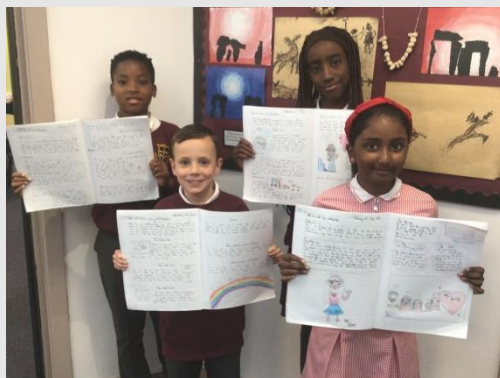
