



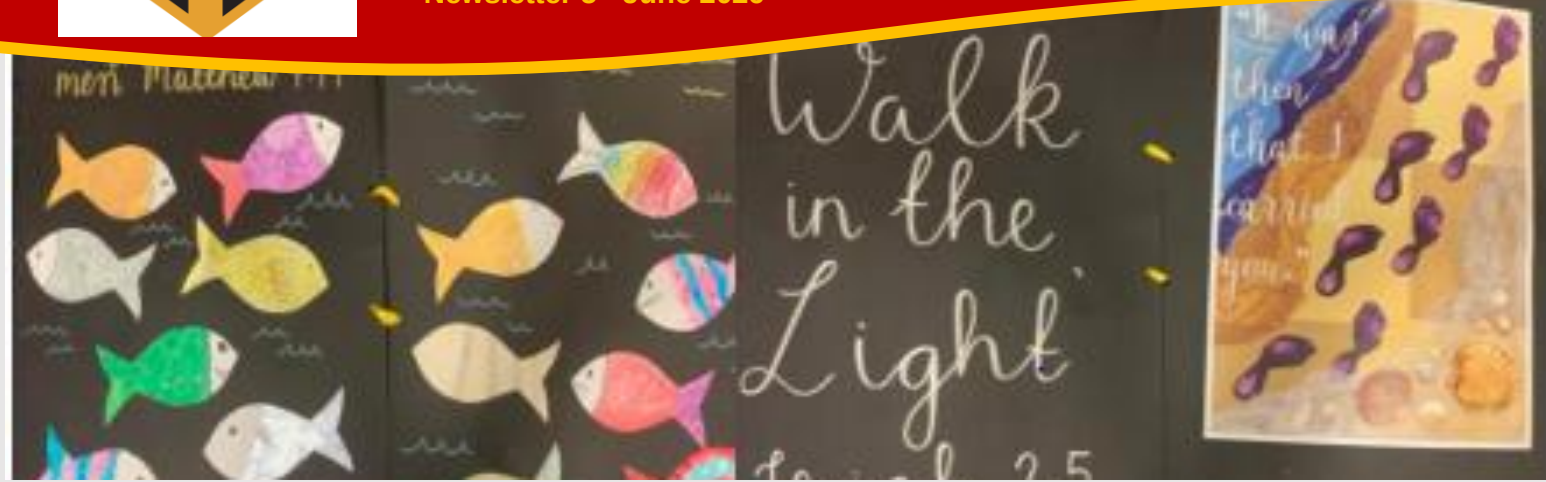

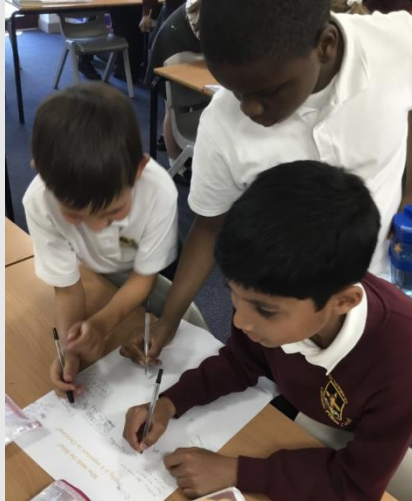


Aspiration-Resilience-Awareness-Compassion

Dialogue and Encounter through Scripture

This week, St Catherine of Siena Class learned about the Old and New Testaments and how the Bible was written over many years.
